FLAG CARRIAGE

American Flag Protocol: The American Flag shall lead when in columns and be kept on the right when riders are aligned or in rows. No deduction for equal distance between riders in a circle 35 _____

Flag Carriage: Shafts perpendicular and elbows parallel to the ground; elbows at a right angle; emblems and flag tops pointed forward; flags kept free from wrapping around the flag pole 15 _____

GENERAL IMPRESSION

Horses clean and in healthy working condition; equipment and uniforms clean, neat, uniform and in good repair. 30 _____

PENALTIES (per occurrence)

Broken Tack or Dropped Equipment: Any piece of tack or adornment that requires the team to stop to fix it or any item that falls to the ground. Each item/occurrence is a 5 point penalty <5> _____

Fall of Horse or Rider:
Fall as a result of a collision is a 100 point penalty. <100> _____

Fall not resulting from a collision is a 25 point penalty. Falls resulting from poor arena conditions shall not be penalized. <25> _____

Over/Under Allotted Time Constraints: Time allowed is not more than 12 minutes. Time is taken from first horse in to last horse out. 10 point penalty each minute or fraction thereof over the limit <10> _____

Drill Time: _____

Off-course: Should the majority of a team be out of position, a drill master may elect to stop the team as well as the time clock and re-group. The team may not start over but they can proceed from a point where last in proper position. The time clock will not be re-set and a 50 point penalty assessed. <50> _____

Re-Group: In the case of a fall of horse or rider, severe tack breakage, or medical emergency, a drill master may elect to re-group; or, should they be unable to continue at the present time due to injury of horse or rider, they may request permission to leave the arena and re-start at the end of the draw. The time clock will not be re-set and a 50 point penalty assessed. <50> _____
