EXECUTION OF DRILL

- Alignment:** Lines are straight; circles are round and centered; riders are aligned when abreast and track when in columns.

50

- Spacing:** Riders and/or sets have equal distance b/w them; spacing may vary in different maneuvers.

50

- Timing & Coordination:** How team members work together to perform the maneuvers. No missed holes, collisions, etc.

- Briskness:** Precise execution, alertness, and overall responsiveness of the team.

PERFORMANCE AND MANNERS OF HORSES

- Performance of horses:** Way of going, no broken gaits.

- Manners of horses:** Well mannered; no kicking, biting, or bucking.

ORIGINALITY AND UNIQUENESS OF PRESENTATION

- Originality:** Original patterns used; method used to present maneuvers.

- Attractiveness of Patters:** Symmetry & Definition of maneuvers; continuity & flow between maneuvers.

DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

- Difficulty of maneuvers and overall drill to include: speed, closeness of spacing; lack of set-up maneuvers; precision not sacrificed for speed; carrying of flags and observation of correct flag protocol.

SPECTACULARITY AND CROWD APPEAL

- Spectacularity:** Maneuvers performed at a faster pace while not sacrificing precision; music compliments the pace and maneuvers of the drill; manner in which the flags are presented.

- Crowd Appeal:** Drill presented in a manner pleasing to what would be a totally unbiased audience, not necessarily the crowd on-hand which could be heavily slanted.

HORSEMANSHIP

Equitation & Horsemanship as adapted for drill purposes, i.e., basic equitation position, hands, and the use of aids.

FLAG CARRIAGE

American Flag Protocol: The American Flag shall lead when in columns and be kept on the right when riders are aligned or in rows. No deduction for equal distance between riders in a circle.

Flag Carriage: Shafts perpendicular and elbows parallel to the ground; elbows at a right angle; emblems and flag tops pointed forward; flags kept free from wrapping around the flag pole.

GENERAL IMPRESSION

Horses clean and in healthy working condition; equipment and uniforms clean, neat, uniform and in good repair.

PENALTIES (per occurrence)

Broken Tack or Dropped Equipment: Any piece of tack or adornment that requires the team to stop to fix it or any item that falls to the ground. Each item/occurrence is a 5 point penalty.

Fall of Horse or Rider:

Fall as a result of a collision is a 100 point penalty.

100 x _____

Fall not resulting from a collision is a 25 point penalty. Falls resulting from poor arena conditions shall be at the judge's discretion.

Over Allotted Time Constraints: Time allowed is not more than 5 minutes. 25 point penalty each minute or fraction thereof over the limit.

Drill Time: _____

Re-Group: A drill coach may elect to re-group the team at their discretion. Re-group is defined as the drill team changing positions while the team has been stopped during drill. This penalty does not apply to horses/riders which move to mitigate safety issues, to re-mount, or during the substitution of a horse/rider as decided by the Show Chairperson. A re-group is a 100 point penalty.

100 x _____

Re-Start: A drill team which has an injury during their drill which necessitates the removal of a rider and/or horse, may elect to re-enter at a later time as approved by the Show Chairperson. They will be assessed a 100 point penalty and their time will not be reset. Only one re-entry is allowed.
