Drill Team Divisions

Junior:	All riders must be under 18 years of age as of December 1, 2007
Senior:	All riders must be 18 years of age and over as of December 1, 2007
Mixed:	Riders of all ages
Novice:	Any age, freestyle drill only
Exhibition:	A non-scored division open to any drill team of any age

Entry Fees

Junior, Senior, Mixed, & Novice	\$250 received on or before September 6 / \$400 after
Exhibition	\$150 received on or before September 6 / \$250 after
Teams not members of WSEDTA add	\$100

Awards

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st place team in each division and ribbons will be awarded to teams placing 1st through 5th in each division. This is the 2008 WSEDTA Championship Competition, the culmination of the WSEDTA Championship Series. Points earned at this show and throughout the year will be tabulated to crown the 2008 Division Champions as well as the 2008 Grand Champion. The Grand Champions will receive 17 belt buckles and the Division Champion and Grand Champion teams will be provided with a WSEDTA Championship flag to be carried throughout the next year.

Stalls

\$65 per stall for the entire weekend (Friday thru Sunday). Thursday night is available for an extra \$25. If stalls are not used, a grounds fee of \$25 per horse per day will be required. Horses will not be allowed to tie-up overnight. Only straw is allowed in the stalls and 1 bail per 2 stalls will be provided by WSEDTA at no charge. No refunds after September 6.

General Information

The competition will be held in the Chris Beck arena beginning at approximately 8:00 am. Junior, Senior, and Mixed divisions will be required to do a short drill with required maneuvers as well as a freestyle drill. The novice division requires a freestyle drill only. The Chris Beck arena will be available on Friday only for pre-arranged practice rides. A Hospitality Center will be open throughout the weekend for everyone. Breakfast and lunch will be provided on Friday and Saturday as well as refreshments and water throughout the weekend. The fee is \$15 p/p and is mandatory for riders and optional for others. In continuing with WSEDTA tradition, there will be a BBQ on Saturday evening immediately following the competition for all riders, staff, parents, family, and friends at \$10 p/p. A team dish is requested. RV camping is available on the fairgrounds; see the camping reservation form for more details. All riders must sign a WSEDTA waiver prior to riding.
