Drill Team Divisions

- Colorguard:** Four riders presenting four flags to the judges and audience - riders of all ages may ride.
- Military:** Teams proudly displaying their military heritage - riders of all ages may ride.
- Quad:** Four riders from a starting or existing team - riders of all ages may ride.
- Rodeo:** Teams with fast-paced drills that thrill rodeo audiences - riders of all ages may ride.
- Novice:** Teams just starting out in competitive drill - riders of all ages may ride
- Junior:** All riders must be under 18 as of 12/01/2010 - long and short drill required
- Mixed:** Any age of riders - long and short drill required
- Senior:** All riders must be 18 or older as of 12/01/2010 - long and short drill required
- Overall:** Teams from the Junior, Mixed, and Senior divisions competing for the overall show title

Stabling

General Information

This is a two-day competition; practice rides will be between 7:00-10:00 am on Friday and Saturday, with competition rides in the evening each night. The Rodeo division will kick the competition off on Friday night at 6:30 pm followed by Military division and short program drills. Friday night will end with a BBQ social. Saturday night will begin with the Colorguard competition at 6:00 pm followed by the Quad division at 6:30 and then freestyle drills. At the conclusion of the event the top three teams in each division will receive awards and the grand champion will receive 12 limited edition California State Drill Team Champion buckles. The BJ Romero sportsmanship award will also be presented during closing ceremonies. A hospitality tent will provide breakfast and BBQ lunch for \$15/day. All riders are requested to participate; family and friends are welcome as well. RV camping is available and the Charter Inn & Suites is a local hotel. 2011 tee shirts are available on a pre-order basis only.
